When I/ was a child, my mother told me, “Don’t do what others don’t like”.

So, I will try to make my presentation as short as possible.

Before I begin, I would like to express my deepest sympathy to all the victims of war and natural disasters around the world, including those who have been affected by the Los Angeles wildfires. Let us hope that the day of peace will come soon.

Paris 2024 was a historic success, thanks to all the athletes, thanks to the leadership of President Thomas Bach and thanks to the excellent work of the Paris Organizing Committee.

However, I believe that we should not be satisfied and that we must build on the success of these Games.

Because, in contrast to the spectacular Olympic Games, the situation of the NOCs is far from strong.

As FIG President, I have visited 162 countries.

I have seen with my own eyes the situation of our sport in each country.

As a result I saw the reality.

Economically,

these countries are not wealthy.

In many countries, their relations with government are not good.

Olympians

have no guarantee of a career once they retire.

In addition,

the way people look at the Olympic Games is not always warm and welcoming.

The presence of sport in each country is not high enough.

I used to be a gymnast myself.

That's why I believe sport has even greater potential.

To unleash that potential I propose that the Games be held on all five continents at the same time.

We respect Baron de Coubertin, and share his ideals of Olympism.

The purpose of the Olympic Games is for as many people as possible to understand Olympism and to contribute to the development of sport and peace.

## Key Benefits

### For the Athletes

Each sport will take place in one of five countries that offers the best climate, and facilities for that sport.

### For the Host countries

Each country will host 10 sports, greatly reducing the financial burden.

### For Marketing and TV rights

There will be 24 hours coverage, broader sponsorship potential, and a new source of continental sponsorships.

And The IOC, it's self can not organize the Games on five continents at the same time.

Cooperation between the IOC, the Continental OCs, and the IFs will be essential.

And we should create a stronger sense of unity within the Olympic Movement.

We know that 2036 is already under discussion, so the earliest we could introduce this initiative would be 2040.

Secondary, I propose that the Olympian Forum be held after the Games to create the spirit of friendship under one roof.

Because during the Games, in reality athletes are too focused on their competitions.

The Olympian Forum will be attended by Olympians, IOC members, Global companies, Media, and NGOs.

It's a chance for athletes to explore second-career opportunities and interact directly with many world leaders.

Now, let me change the Subject.

I will briefly introduce my achievements as FIG President.

Because my father always told me "People trust what you have done, not just what you say."

Protect athletes

I established an independent Gymnastics Ethics Foundation.

If harassment occurs, athletes can call for help.

A lot of harassment still exists in the shadows.

We need to improve the safeguarding system for athletes.

AI in sports

Gymnastics has already introduced AI judging.

Now we are developing AI coaching.

Wherever you are in the world, you can be coached by world-class coaches by AI.

Sport and Peace

I created a 'Sport and Peace' Commission.

We need to think even more deeply about how we can contribute to peace.

Sports and Aging Society

In the near future, 50% of the world's population will be over 65 years old, straining social security systems.

The FIG is launching a project to show how sports can reduce social security costs.

Many companies are joining - IT, Finance, Pharma, Food, Sports and Automotive companies.

Because future consumers want health over goods.

In the 18th century in England, the industrial revolution began with Steam.

I believe the 21st century industrial revolution will be driven by sports and healthcare.

So, which organization is best placed to lead this transformation globally?  
It is the IOC.

I envision upgrading the current IOC into a “World Sports Organization”.  
It's like the World Health Organization.

The World Sports Organization will not focus only on the Olympic Games.  
It will support the world through the power of sports.  
If we become the World Sports Organization, our activities will expand.

And we can ensure

Democracy, Transparency, Gender equality, Independence from politics,  
and extend the retirement age.

This could resolve the dilemma we face today.

And I believe it will increase the presence of sport in society.

I am always up for new challenges.

Because the future is not an extension of the past.

We have to create our own future.

There are many professionals here.

Athletes, Royalty, Politicians, Lawyers, Bankers, and many others.

If we work together, we can do anything.

Let's open the door to a new era.

Finally, I would like to thank our President Thomas Bach, for organizing this event.

Seven candidates have spoken with passion and all the IOC members have listened and thought about the future of the IOC.

This is a wonderful thing.

This is what creates the future by sports.
